CR OF THE LEFT KNEE COMPLETE 4 OR MORE VIEWS

CLINICAL HISTORY: Knee pain.

COMMENTS:

Moderate to severe tricompartmental degenerative changes are noted, demonstrated by marked osteophytosis, endplate sclerosis and significant joint space narrowing, involving the medial compartment to the greater degree.

Large suprapatellar joint effusion is noted.

There is no fracture or dislocation. There is no chondrocalcinosis. The patella is normal in position and appearance.

IMPRESSION:

- 1. No fracture or dislocation.
- 2. Moderate to severe tricompartmental degenerative changes.
- 3. Large suprapatellar joint effusion.
- 4. Consider follow up with MRI.
